2. These awards will honor individuals or groups of individuals who have shown dedication and leadership that relates to the mission of the E9-1-1 Institute, which:
 - Serves as an information clearinghouse on E9-1-1 and emergency communications issues and distributes timely, relevant information to Members of Congress, Administration officials, federal, state, and local public safety officials, and the general public;
 - Creates a forum for policy discussions related to E9-1-1 and emergency communications that will benefit public policy development; and
 - Assists members of the Congressional E9-1-1 Caucus in promoting public education on E9-1-1 issues.
3. Actions that are eligible are actions that took place during calendar year 2006.
4. In addition to this form, you are welcome to submit additional information, such as:
 - Press coverage;
 - More detailed materials;
 - Other relevant information;

The Institute may consider additional information but the nomination form will be the primary information source. Please keep in mind that **quality** is more important than **quantity**.

9-1-1 Call-Taker/Dispatcher Award:

This award honors the “First responders”—the **9-1-1 call-takers** and **dispatchers** who are on the front line every. Candidates for this honor should have a proven track record of service in the field and a reputation for going the extra mile on behalf of emergency callers.

Citizen in Action:

The Citizen in Action award honors **someone** who demonstrated **exceptional bravery** and **heroism** to save a life in a critical time using 9-1-1.

First Responder Award:

The First Responder Award recognizes those individuals that 9-1-1 people call—e.g. **Law Enforcement, Fire Rescue** and or **Emergency Medical Service providers**—for their professionalism, initiative, creativity or diligence in assisting a person reporting and/or experiencing an emergency situation.

Government Leader Award (Federal):

This award recognizes the **federal government leader** that has done the most to **advance the capabilities of 9-1-1** emergency communications.

Government Leader Award (Local):

This award recognizes the *state or local government leader* that has done the most to **advance the capabilities of 9-1-1** emergency communications.

Industry Professional Award:

The Industry Professional Award honors an **individual** or **organization** in the **commercial sector** that has demonstrated exceptional contributions towards the advancement of emergency 9-1-1 communications

Media/Entertainment Award:

This award recognizes the **media** or **entertainment individual** or **organization** that has done the most to improve public understanding and support for 9-1-1 emergency communications.

Outstanding 9-1-1 Call Center Award:

This award recognizes a **state, regional** or **local 9-1-1 program** for its excellence in key emergency communications areas ranging from the handling of emergency situations reported to 9-1-1 to the deployment and management of new technology.
