 - Creates a forum for policy discussions related to E9-1-1 and emergency communications that will benefit public policy development; and
 - Assists members of the Congressional E9-1-1 Caucus in promoting public education on E9-1-1 issues.
3. Actions that are eligible are actions that took place during calendar year 2007.

 - Other relevant information;

The Institute may consider additional information but the nomination form will be the primary information source. Please keep in mind that **quality** is more important than **quantity**.

2008 Nomination Form / 9-1-1 Honor Award Categories

Please indicate the award for which you are nominating this candidate.

- 9-1-1 Call-Taker/Dispatcher Award:** This award honors the *“first responders”*—the **9-1-1 Call-Takers and Dispatchers** who are on the front line every. Candidates for this honor should have a proven track record of service in the field and a reputation for going the extra mile on behalf of emergency callers.
- Citizen in Action:** The **Citizen in Action** award honors *someone* who demonstrated *exceptional bravery* and *heroism* to save a life in a critical time using 9-1-1.
- First Responder Award:** The **First Responder Award** recognizes those individuals that 9-1-1 people call—e.g. *Law Enforcement, Fire Rescue* and or *Emergency Medical Service providers*—for their professionalism, initiative, creativity or diligence in assisting a person reporting and/or experiencing an emergency situation.
- Government Leader Award (Federal):** This award recognizes the **Federal Government Leader** that has done the most to *advance the capabilities of 9-1-1* emergency communications.
- Government Leader Award (Local):** This award recognizes the **State or Local Government Leader** that has done the most to *advance the capabilities of 9-1-1* emergency communications.
- Industry Professional Award:** The **Industry Professional Award** honors an *individual* or *organization* in the *commercial sector* that has demonstrated exceptional contributions towards the advancement of emergency 9-1-1 communications.
- 9-1-1 Technician Award:** This award recognizes the Technology Support staff—e.g. *Information Technology, GIS and other technical personnel within a 9-1-1 authority* or *jurisdiction* whose tireless efforts make available and maintain the critical technology systems necessary to answer, process and respond to emergency calls.
- Outstanding 9-1-1 Call Center Award:** This award recognizes a *state, regional* or *local 9-1-1 program* for its excellence in key emergency communications areas ranging from the handling of emergency situations reported to 9-1-1 to the deployment and management of new technology.


